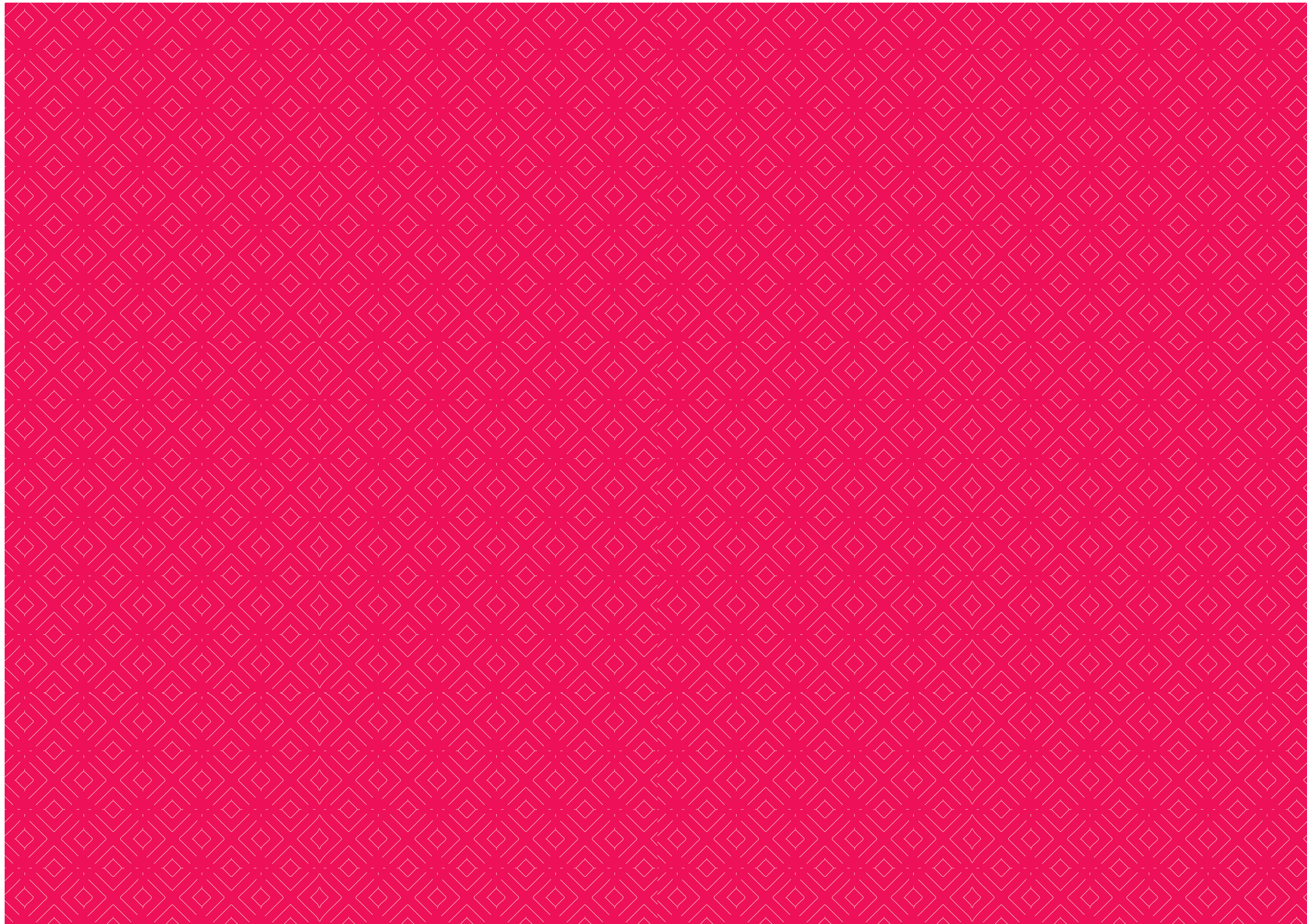

Suddenly, they hear a bird singing a beautiful tune.



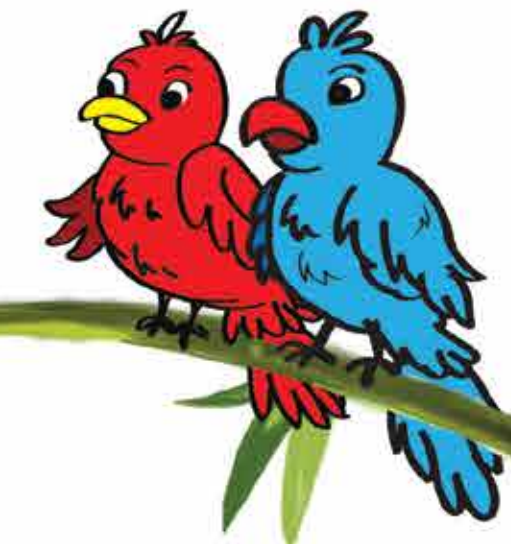
The children look up and see a beautiful red parrot sitting on the branch. They count 1...



A moment later, a blue parrot lands on the branch. They count 1, 2...

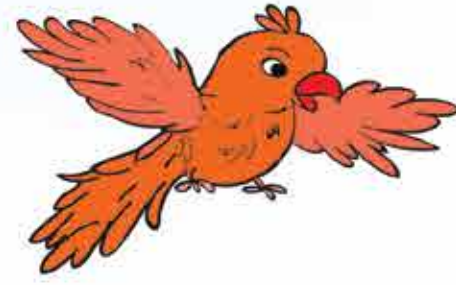


And just as they finish counting to two, a yellow parrot lands on the branch.

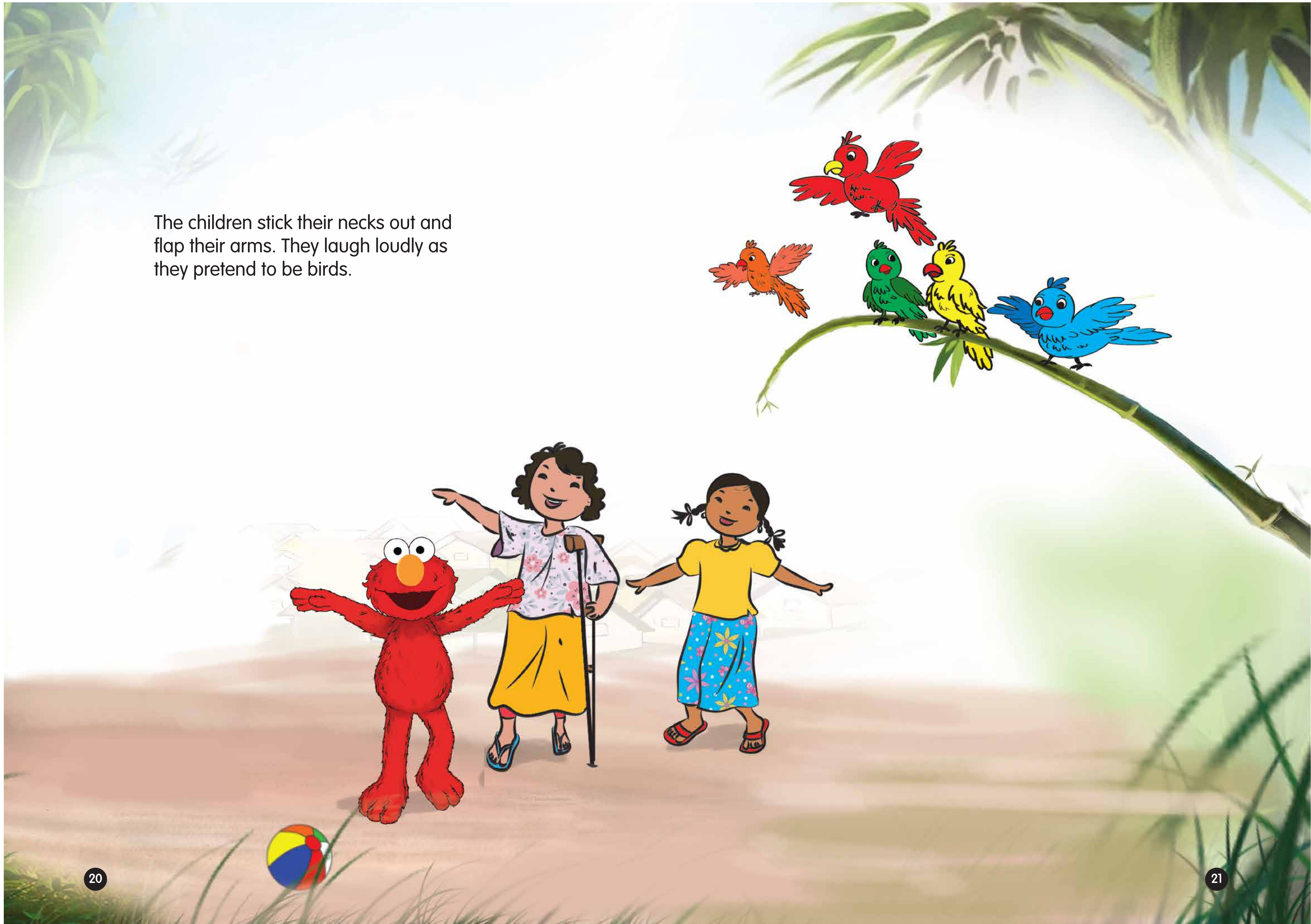
Jusna, Munira, and Elmo are so happy to have counted the birds. "Wow! How colorful these five birds are," says Elmo.
