




Going Fishing

"This can be your boat," she says.




Mae joins them. She gets a wooden spoon from Sokina Bibi.

Raya screams, "I saw a fish pass by. I think it was a small, silver-colored fish!" Mae stops the boat.


Raya picks up a stick with a long thread. Raya is going to catch first. She throws the fishing line in the water.

Laughter on our face".




Soon they reach home.
