Abby waves her wand.

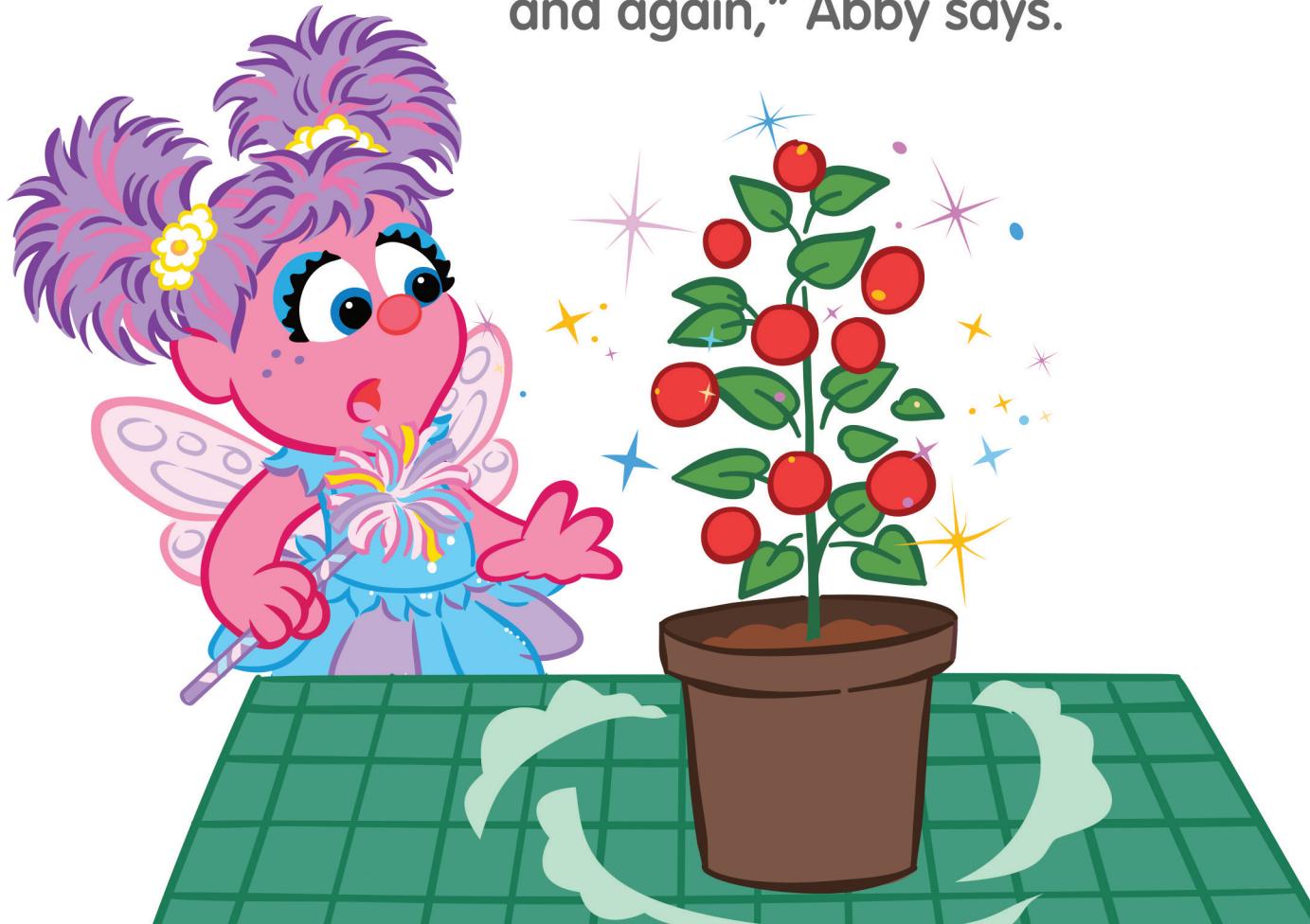
She thinks about Bel

Elmo loves books! Looking at books helps his body rest.

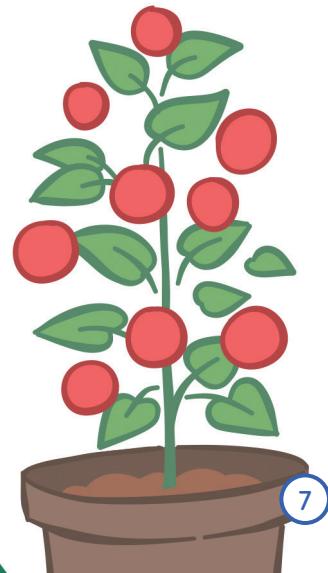
Resting is a healthy choice.

Abby waves her wand. She thinks about Chamki and her doing karate.

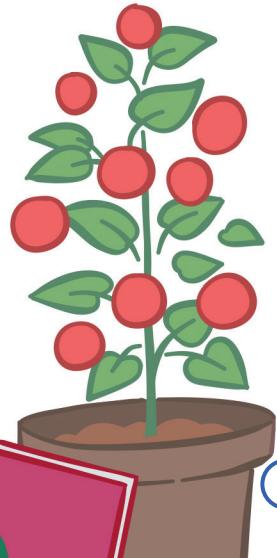


Did she make a picture of Chamki?
